Why analyze saliva?

How do we get a saliva sample from your child?

It is a simple process of 'swish and spit.' Your child swishes purified water for 10-12 seconds and spits it into a cup. Simple.

Why should I do this?

The **mySaliva** report you take home gives a picture of your child's oral environment and recommendations you can do to improve problem areas. It allows you to be involved in your child's oral health and wellbeing.

Why can't you tell me what is happening with a normal exam?

Saliva gives us information that can't be seen. It is analyzed by a medical device to indicate the general health of teeth and gums. Paired with your clinical evaluation and health history, saliva analysis gives your dentist a detailed picture of your oral health so they can create a personalized treatment plan.

Understanding Your Results ...

This new information on the **mySaliva** • report can indicate to your dental care team if you are at an increased risk to develop cavities and gum disease. Using the report as a guide, you and your dental care team can discuss how to improve oral health through better hygiene practices, along with products and treatments that best fit your needs.

The top chart shows your overall oral health results for today and progress over time. Using 2 or 3 results reports, you can see which areas are progressing and which areas need improvement.

2 Categorizing Risk

For each of the 7 indicators, mySaliva √° report displays your result as low, moderate, or high. In areas where you are higher, you are more vulnerable to develop undesirable oral conditions.
